

Directions for Venue Rental Management and Pricing of the College of Engineering of National Sun Yat-sen University

1. The Directions for Venue Rental Management and Pricing (hereinafter referred to as “the Directions”) of the College of Engineering (hereinafter referred to as “the College”) are formulated in accordance with the Regulations for Venue and Facility Rental Pricing of National Sun Yat-sen University (hereinafter referred to as “NSYSU”) in order to effectively improve the benefits of venue utilization and maintenance and management in the College.
2. Venues of the College are used for educational and research purposes. They are available for rent as long as no impact on teaching or research results.
3. An applicant shall refer to the Venue and Equipment Price List of the College (Attachment 1) and fill out the Venue Rental Application Form (Attachment 2). After the unit of the College in charge of the requested venue approves the application, the applicant needs to confirm the reservation and pay the fee one week prior to the event. Late confirmation or payment will be considered cancellation.
4. Venue pricing standards of the College are described below:
 - (1) Venue rental rate includes air-conditioning, venue maintenance, and equipment maintenance fees.
 - (2) 60% of venue capacity must be achieved for any event in order to maximize venue performance. The application form shall be submitted with the event plan, introduction, or description.
 - (3) A discount of 50% is offered for any event organized by the College according to the charging standards of NSYSU.
 - (4) A discount of 40% is offered for any event co-organized by the College and a unit of NSYSU according to the charging standards of NSYSU.
 - (5) A discount of 40% is offered for any event co-organized by the College and an external organization according to the charging standards of NSYSU for external parties.
 - (6) A discount of 20% is offered for any event co-organized by a unit of NSYSU and an external organization according to the charging standards of NSYSU for external parties.
 - (7) Any student organization or club is allowed to borrow Classroom EN0028 of the Building of Mechanical and Electromechanical Engineering and Classroom EC0001 of the Building of Electrical Engineering for free as long as no impact on teaching or research of the College results.
 - (8) Venues are available for the rest of units under NSYSU during opening hours.
 - (9) The unit of the College in charge of the requested venue reviews the identity of the applicant, the total rental fee, and the reservation period before approving the application.

5. Venue Use Rules:

- (1) The borrower shall clean up spaces inside and outside the venue. All the items brought to the venue shall be immediately discarded or removed after the event. The rented venue shall be returned to its original state. The unit of the College in charge of the rented venue is not liable for keeping borrowers' assets safe.
 - (2) The borrower shall keep equipment in the venue safe and secure. Equipment cannot be moved without permission. Electricity connection and installation of other audio-visual equipment are also prohibited without permission. The full replacement cost shall be paid for any damaged items.
 - (3) The borrower shall ensure safety and security of the venue and participants.
 - (4) The College has the right to immediately call off any event if the borrower sublets the rented venue to another party without permission, the venue is used for a purpose not stated in the application form, the event is associated with immoral actions, the event leads to a breach of laws and regulations or rules of NSYSU, or there is a risk of damage to the environment and facilities of the College; it will not refund the full amount of the payment, and will disqualify the borrower permanently from applying in the future, and report to NSYSU if the borrower commits serious violation.
6. Matters not stated in the Directions shall be handled according to relevant rules of NSYSU.
7. The Directions become effective after being approved at the College Affairs Meeting and Administration Meeting, as well as ratified by the President. Amendments to the Directions shall follow the same procedure.
